



JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN - AGE 4

Play still fulfills a meaningful role in the children's acquisition of knowledge and skills. Group activity is carefully guided to enhance cooperation and respect for individual personalities and differences.



KINDERGARTEN / PRIMARY
AGES 5 - 6

Kindergarten/Primary comprises a period of transition from predominantly play-based learning to more formal education. It is a big step. Emerging abstract reasoning complements concrete experiences. Math concepts and language expression become more sophisticated. Differentiation of instruction becomes increasingly important as students develop in different ways and at different rates.

Exciting, hands-on activities promote cognitive growth, including solid skill development. Integration of math, science, language, and the arts characterize the curriculum, while growth in personal character and good citizenship continue to be fostered.
